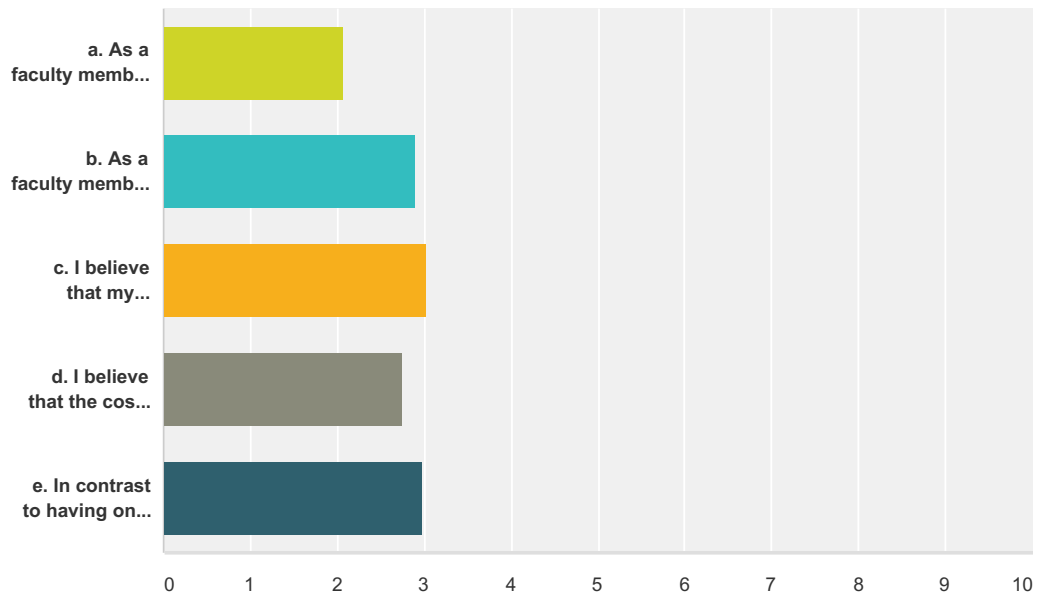

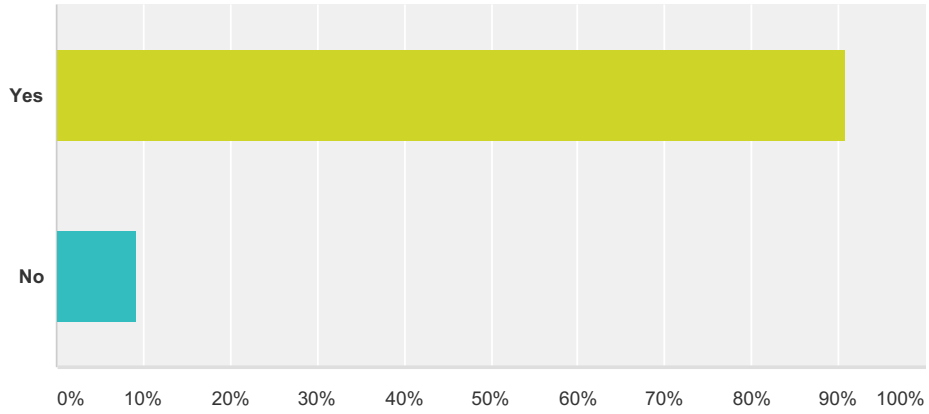

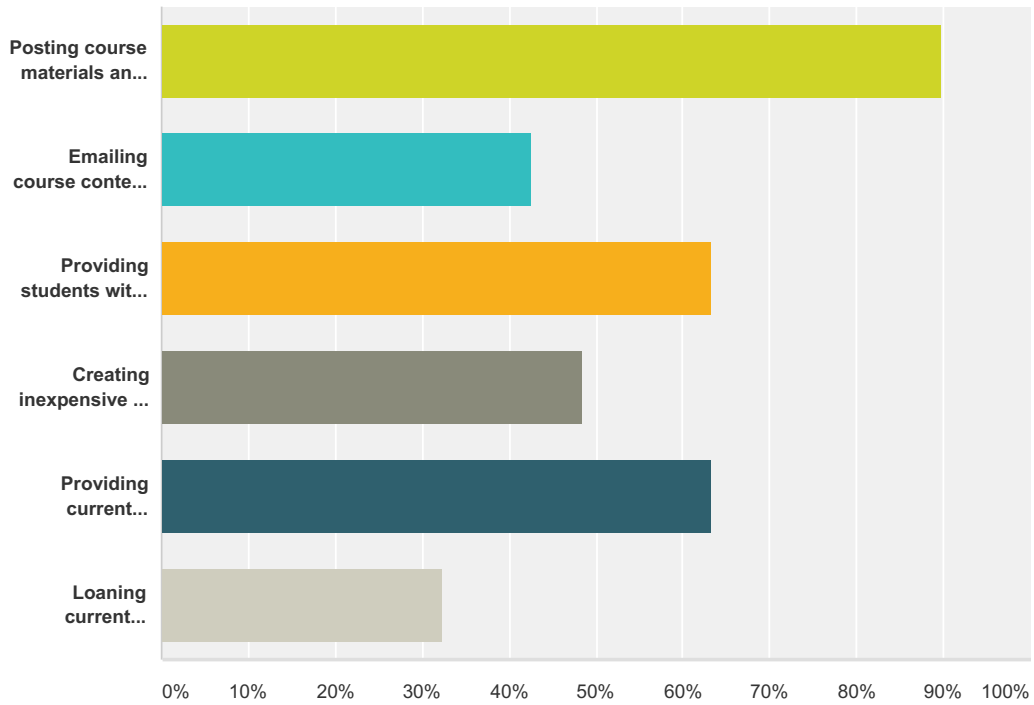

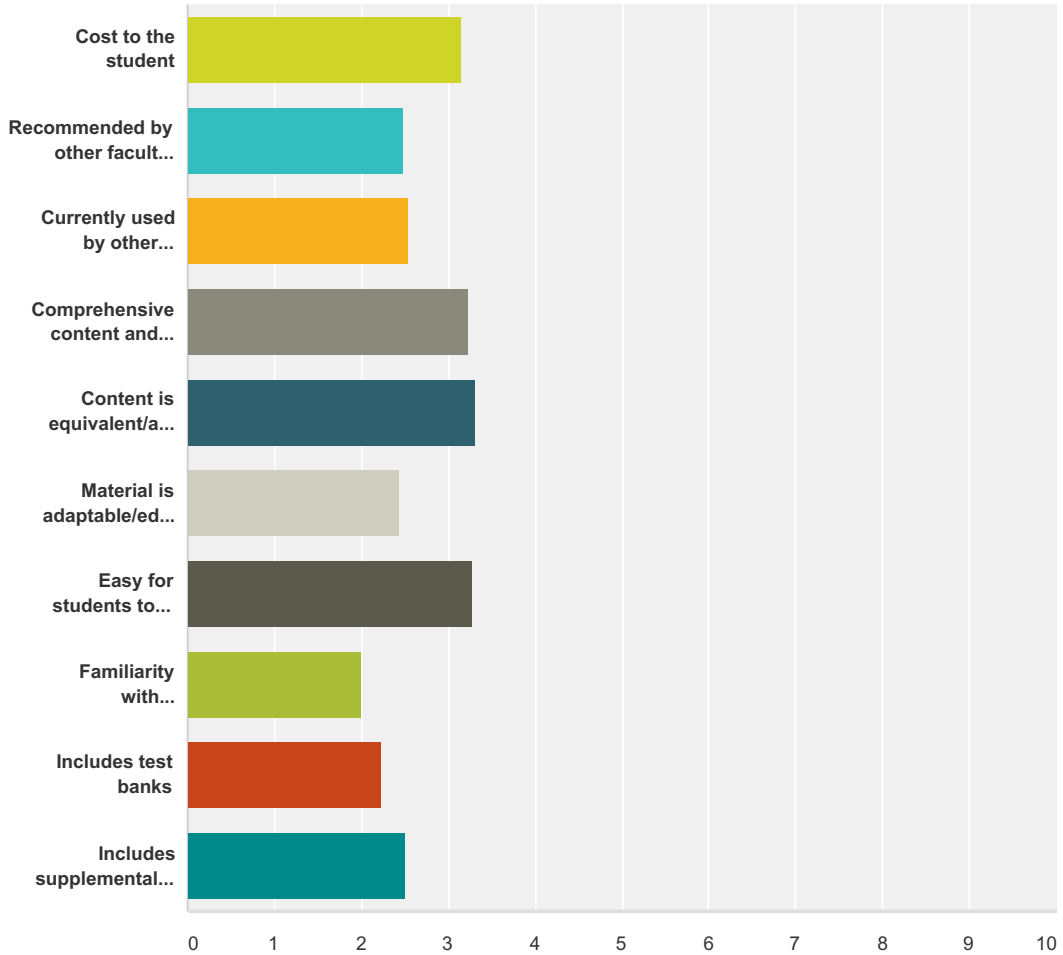

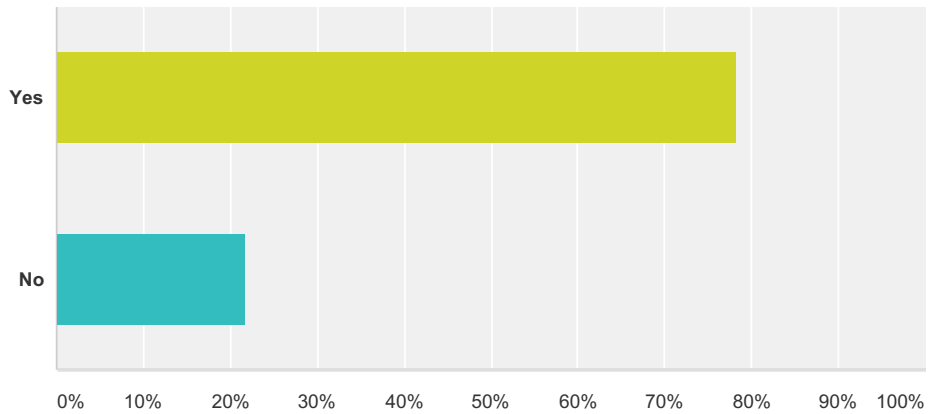

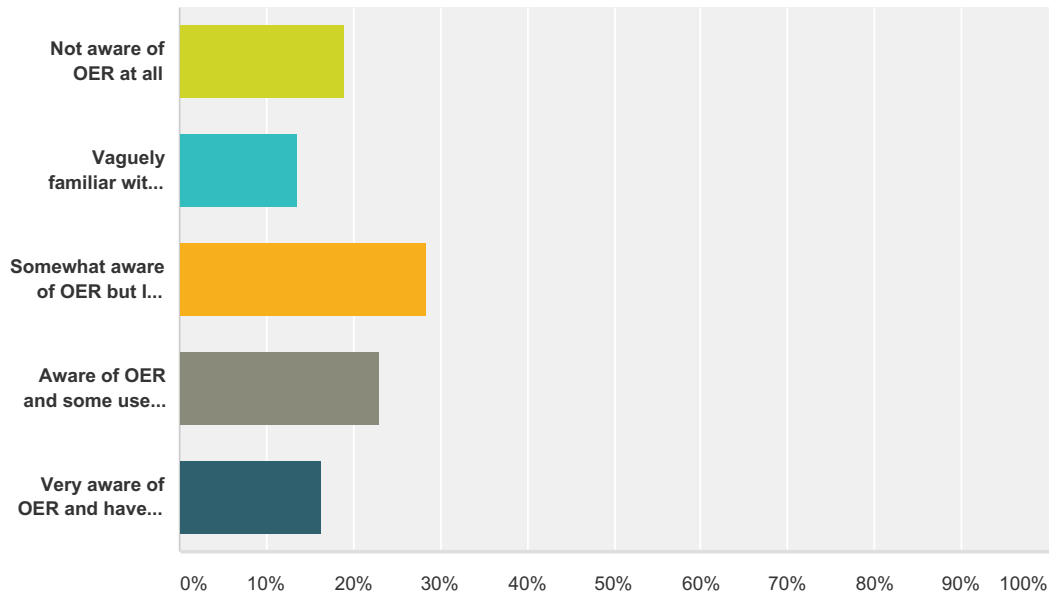

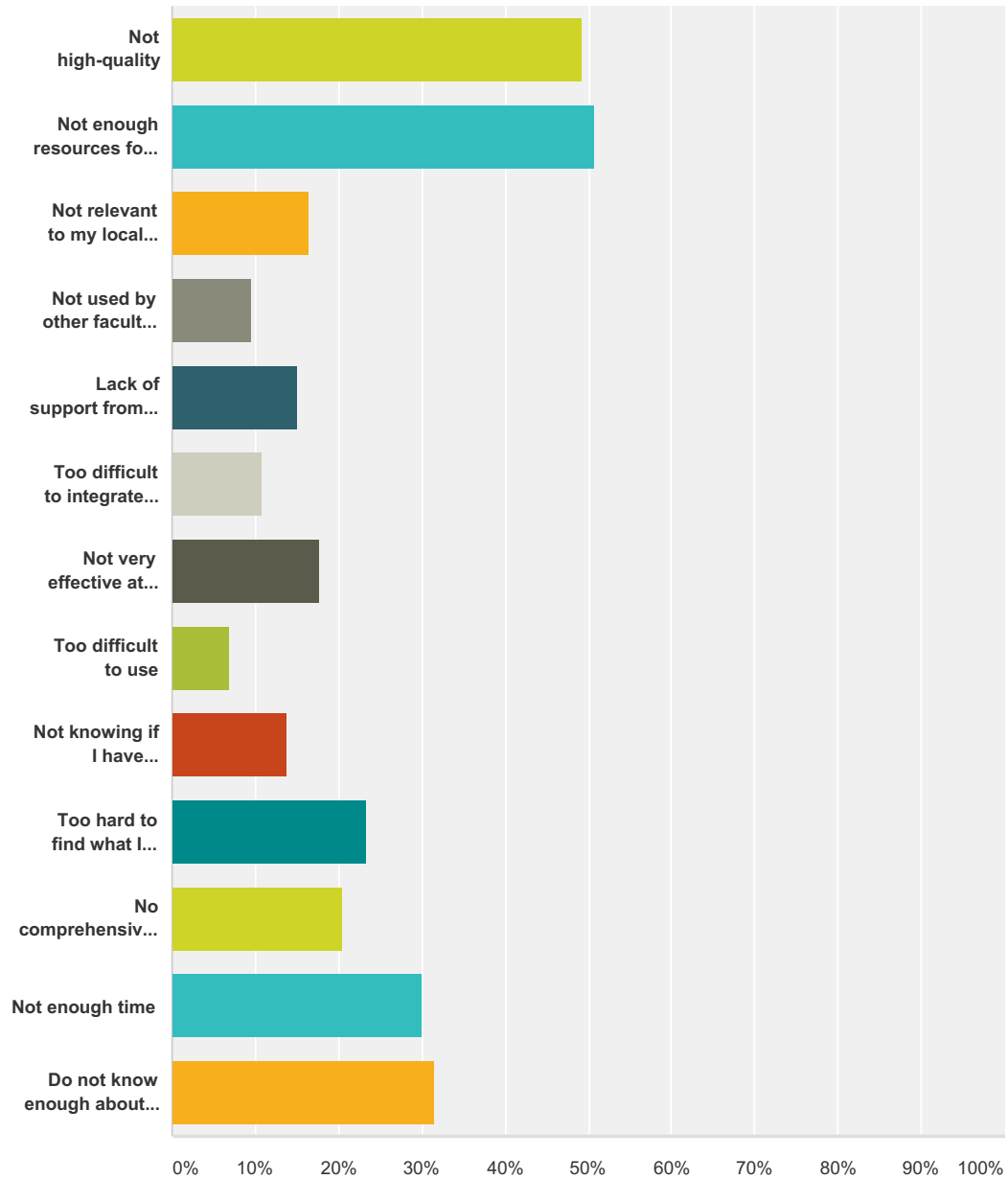

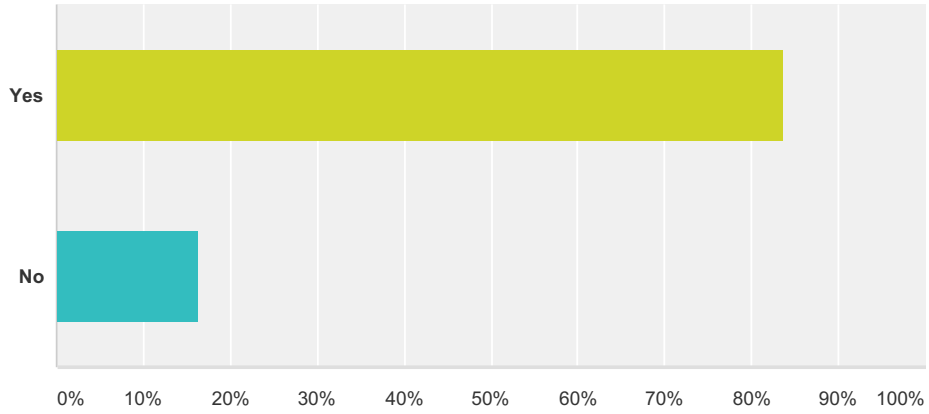

Q12 OER is one option that offers free textbooks for courses. Is this something that you would be interested in learning about?

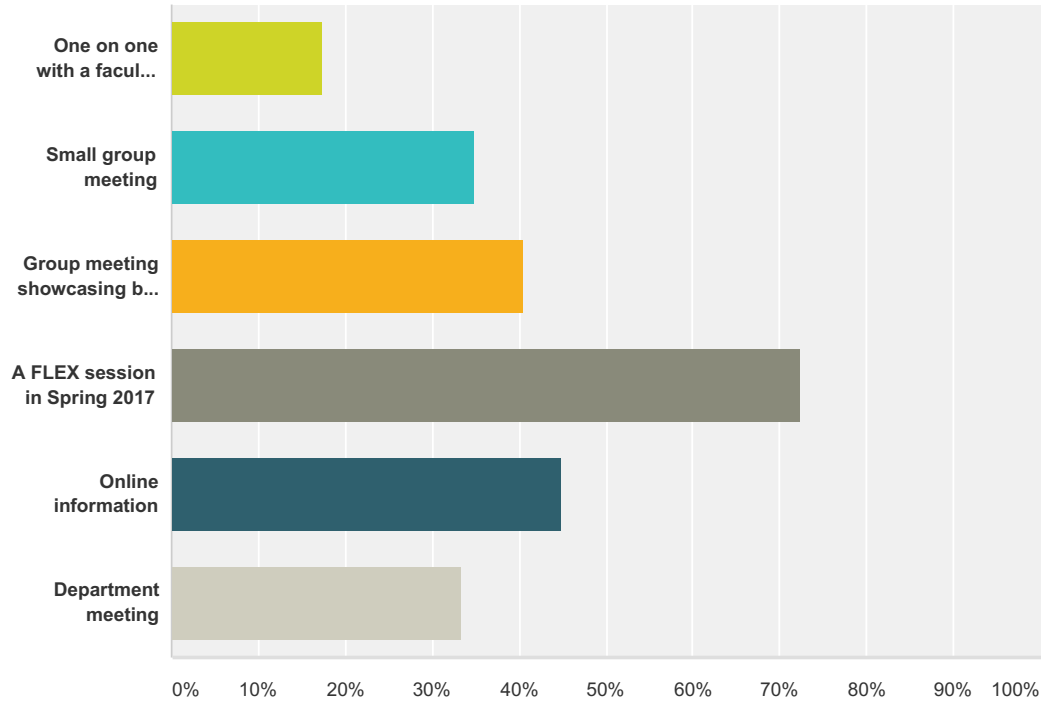
